
Inboard Profile

Southwest/Southcentral Alaska

From the incredible beauty of Prince William Sound to the stunning scenery of Unalaska, this region is home to numerous wildlife refuges, hundreds of species of sea birds, fur seal colonies, walrus, and other marine wildlife. Travelers are treated to spectacular views of glaciers, tranquil fjords, and lush forests as they voyage through the hushed splendor of this route.

Visit Cordova, Valdez, and Whitter in Prince William Sound, then sail on to Seward, Seldovia, Homer, Port Lions, and the former Russian settlement of Kodiak. Take a road trip inland from Valdez, Seward, Whittier, or Homer. Then reboard to see the fabulously wild Aleutians!

Inside Passage/Southeast Alaska

This magical land of forests, fjords, peaceful communities, and abundant wildlife will enchant you with its mixture of Alaska Native, early Russian, and colorful Gold Rush history. The Inside Passage and Southeast routes provide connections between all Southeast ports and the continental road system, as well as to the Southcentral/Southwest routes via the Cross-Gulf trip. From either Prince Rupert or Bellingham, enjoy stopping in charming ports like Ketchikan, Wrangell, Petersburg, Sitka, and Juneau on your way to the historic towns of Haines and Skagway. You can also take trips to the communities of Metlakatla, Kake, Angoon, Tenakee, Pelican, and Hoonah while in Southeast.

Cross-Gulf

Crossing the Gulf of Alaska on an Alaska Marine Highway vessel is an experience not to be missed for those with an appreciation of unspoiled beauty and an appetite for comfortable adventure. Enjoy the beauty and tranquility of a voyage between Juneau and Seward, stopping in Valdez—and perhaps Yakutat—along the way. You'll see whales, seals, glaciers, and magnificent mountain ranges as you traverse the pristine waters of this route, which links the northern regions of Alaska to the rest of the United States.
